



## **THEOLOGY TEACHER – FULL TIME TEMPORARY**

### **PREAMBLE**

Boston College High School is a Catholic, Jesuit, independent school serving approximately 1400 young men across grades 7-12 from various communities across Massachusetts. ### **ROLE PURPOSE**

Boston College High School seeks a full-time temporary Theology Teacher for approximately mid-October through mid-February of the 2024-2025 academic year.

The teacher will teach four sections: two classes of 9<sup>th</sup> grade Foundations of Faith and two classes of 11<sup>th</sup> grade Ethics/Social Justice.

Proctoring duties as necessary.

  - A Master's Degree in Theology and/or Divinity Studies or equivalent.
  - Experience teaching at the high school level.
  - Knowledge of, and commitment to, diversity, equity, and inclusion practices.
  - High standards and expectations for students.
